### **Option 1: New 6 classroom temporary unit**

#### For

- Removes old temporary units addressing condition issues;
- Addresses requirement for additional class space;
- Provides additional general purpose (GP) space;
- Small increase in play area;
- Opens up playground space;
- Retains large majority of pupils on one site.

#### **Against**

- Cluny Centre still required for classes; Fairmilehead for nursery;
- Pressure on facilities (e.g. dining, GP, staff, etc.) remains;
- Decant required during June 2015 to allow demolition of TUs;
- Playground space reduced significantly during June 2015;
- Planning? Cluny Centre availability?








### **Option 2: P1 and P2 Annexe**

#### For

- Removes all temporary units from main school site;
- Classes no longer required at Cluny Centre;
- Reduced pressure on school facilities (e.g. playground, dining, GP, staff, etc.);
- No decant; no on-site works; no planning requirements;
- Council owned property school as sole users;
- Lift access; grassed outdoor area;

#### **Against**

- School separated over 3 distinct sites;
- Distance: logistical issues for drop-off and school management.
